A Body of Evidence should include work from the R-BOE, in-class investigations, and End-of-Module Assessments that demonstrate a student’s level of proficiency. Investigation & Experimentation evidence is embedded in the content evidence. FOSS California Assessment Checklists and Anecdotal Notes maybe used to keep a record of observations and oral responses to questions as evidence for individual students.
