

Rules for “Walk-In” Auditions

If you did not submit an online audition request, there is the possibility that you may still audition for this year’s SDUSD Honor Groups, but you must abide by the following guidelines in order to do so as a “walk-in” audition.

1. Arrive at the audition site (Serra High School), find the room where your instrument is being heard, and sign up for an open audition spot **before** 6:00 PM.
 - a. At 6:00 PM, adjudicators will black out all of the blank audition spots, and no more “walk-in” auditions will be accepted after that time even if there are open spots.
2. Sign up for the **earliest available** audition spot. Adjudicators will move you up if this rule is not followed, and they will not be notifying you of that change.
 - a. EXAMPLE: Auditions are completely open starting at 7:00 PM. You sign up for the 8:00 PM slot. Your time will be moved up to the 7:00 PM slot, and the adjudicator **will not** track you down to notify you of this change.
3. Open audition spots are available on a first come, first served basis, and we will not be extending audition hours beyond the 5:00 to 9:00 PM window. Once all open spots have been taken, there will not be any added. It is encouraged that you arrive as early as possible to secure an available audition spot.
4. Be ready and waiting outside your instrument’s audition room at least 15 minutes before your time.
5. Have your audition form completed, signed by both a parent/guardian and your director, and ready to turn in to your adjudicator at the beginning of your audition.

No Form = No Audition, No Exceptions
