Honor Band Audition – Thursday February 9 5-9pm

The audition date for the 2011 Honor Band is Thursday, February 9 at Correia Middle School. Auditions will run from 5:00pm to 9:00pm. You may sign-up online for an audition time between **December 5 and February 3**. Auditions will be assigned first-come-first-serve, so sign up early!

Audition Requirements:

Part 1: Scales

C, F, Bb, Eb and G Major (concert pitch) – one octave required. Credit will be given for speed, articulation, and a second octave.
Chromatic Scale – one octave required. Credit will be given for speed, articulation, and additional octaves.

Part 2: Prepared Piece

Students are to prepare this selection as written because their knowledge and use of dynamics, articulations, style, will be noted.

Part 3: Sight-reading.

Students will be given a short piece and will have 1-2 minutes to study before they will perform the selection to the best of their ability. Credit will be given for fluency and correct demonstration of pulse, rhythm, and style.

Audition Tips

- 1) This is not for a grade - so relax and have fun! Show off your skills and be the best salesperson you can!!!
- 2) Observe all tempo markings, dynamics, key signatures, and accidentals.
- 3) Play with the best tone possible.
- 4) Focus on what you think the judge is going to be looking for from each selection. Is it sound, rhythm, note accuracy, articulation, etc.?
- 5) If you have questions about your audition piece, ask your director for help.
- 6) Perform “practice auditions” for your teacher and/or friends. The more you “perform” the less nervous you’ll be on audition night!

Perform the following [Beginning – Downbeat of 16].

Melody
