



## **Free & Reduced-Price Meal Program 2011-2012**

San Diego Unified School District provides eligible iHigh students with free or reduced-price student lunches, which are funded through the federal National School Lunch Program.

The School Lunch Program application will be available starting August 15th on the district web site. Eligibility is based on family income, as determined by the chart included in the application.

To access the online School Lunch Program application (available starting August 15, 2011):

- 1) Go to [www.sandi.net](http://www.sandi.net)
- 2) Click on the gold **Parents** tab across the top of the screen.
- 3) On the left-hand Site Shortcuts menu, click on **School Meal Info/Application**.
- 4) On the left-hand Food Services menu, click on **Apply for Free & Reduced-Price Meals**
- 5) Follow the directions for completing the application.

Students who are eligible for the Free/Reduced Price Lunch program should advise an iHigh staff member one day in advance if they would like to have a lunch delivered to the Fremont campus on any given school day. The district Food Services staff will arrange lunch delivery if notified by 1 PM on the previous day by an iHigh staff member. Lunch may also be ordered one day in advance for students attending activities at Mt. Everest Academy.
