### Steps for Enrolling Your Students

- 1) Send enrollment information via email to Maureen Cottrell: [mcottrell@sandi.net](mailto:mcottrell@sandi.net). Be sure to include:
  - Student name
  - Student ID #
  - Student Email
  - Parent Email
  - Course Number
  - Whether quarter or semester version is requested (semester only for AP, Spanish and French)
  - Any other special designations (for example, schools without grad coaches may request credit recovery)
  - Name of on-site Mentor who will be the contact person for each student (for proctored exams, progress monitoring, etc.)
- 2) For groups of students, please include the information in a spreadsheet rather than individual email messages.
- 3) Sites must have a signed parent permission slip and Academic Honesty agreement on file for each student taking online courses.
- 4) **Please note:** AP, Spanish and French courses are taught by Apex instructors at an extra cost to the district. Each site has an allocated number of enrollments. Students must earn at least a “C” to be eligible to continue enrollment in online AP and World Language courses. Please check with Maureen Cottrell for any questions.
- 5) **DROPS:** We reserve the right to drop students who have not submitted coursework within the first two weeks. Students taking quarter classes will not be allowed to drop after the 4th week in the 9-week quarter. Students taking semester classes will not be allowed to drop after the 6<sup>th</sup> week in an 18-week quarter.

#### Notes for online Core and Elective courses:

- Sites must provide an on-site Mentor for each student, plus any required materials (textbook, headset, etc.).
