Subject: CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT OF HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS IN ADULT EDUCATION COURSES NO LONGER PERMITTED

Brief Explanation:

This circular replaces the circular that senior high school principals and counselors have received annually that provided a list of approved courses senior high school students were permitted to re-take, after the regular school day, in the San Diego Community College District (SDCCD) Continuing Education (Adult Education) program.

Effective for the Class of 2016, senior high school students may no longer concurrently enroll in the SDCCD Continuing Education (Adult Education) program, after the regular school day, for the purpose of re-taking failed courses needed for high school graduation.

Further, effective for the Class of 2016, senior high school students may no longer concurrently enroll in the SDUSD Adult School (HSDP), after the regular school day, for the purpose of re-taking failed courses needed for high school graduation.

New SDUSD graduation requirements, effective for the Class of 2016, stipulate that high school courses must be UC "a-g" approved. High school courses offered by the SDCCD Continuing Education (Adult Education) program and SDUSD Adult School (HSDP) are not UC "a-g" approved. Further, recently passed AB 104 stipulates that students under 18 years of age may no longer enroll in courses supported by revenue from the Adult Education Block Grant. Therefore, senior high school counselors no longer have the option to refer students to concurrently enroll in adult education programs, after the regular school day, to re-take courses needed for graduation.
